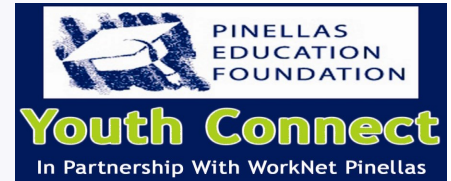


YOUTH CONNECT PROGRAM

What is Youth Connect?

Youth Connect provides guidance, assistance with vocational and academic training, work readiness and employment opportunities to low income youth.



Who Qualifies for Youth Connect?

Program eligibility includes economically disadvantaged youth between the ages of 16 and 21 who have dropped out of school, are ex-offenders, in foster care, homeless, pregnant or parenting, unemployed or underemployed and those with basic skills deficiencies.



How Can Youth Connect Help?

The Youth Connect Program is designed to provide services and resources aimed at helping youth to enroll and successfully complete academic or job related learning, develop leadership skills and to prepare for further education or employment.

The following services are available for eligible youth:

- Comprehensive Guidance and Counseling
- Alternative Secondary Education Services
- Occupational Skills Training Assistance
- Leadership Development / Work Readiness
- Paid Work Experience
- On the Job Training
- Support Services
- Case Management and On-going Support
- Job Placement Assistance
