Teacher/Senior Citizen Admission Tickets are \$10 and will include food and a cash bar will be available.

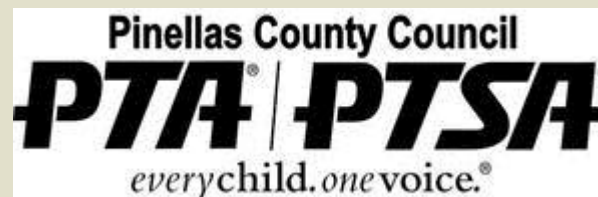

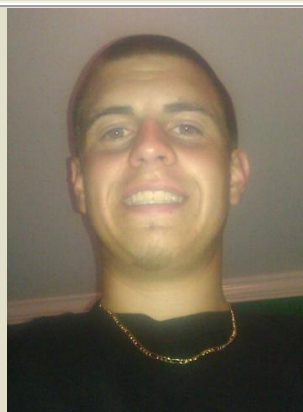
